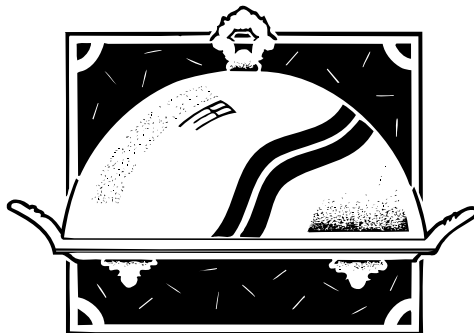

Golf News

We are presently planning on starting our 2008 Elks Scrambles Golf League at Rackham Golf Course on Wednesday, April 23rd (weather permitting) and would like to use this as a 'standing invitation' for new members, current members and those of you who just recently joined the Royal Oak Elks Club, to come out with us and join the weekly fun-day of Golf with other Elk members and their friends. We usually play from 26 to 30 weeks up to the end of November when we have our Annual Golf Banquet at the Lodge.

Every person playing each week is placed in an A - B - C - or D category (depending on their honest (?) estimate of their current handicap. Depending on how each person plays each week, they could move up or down in their designated category. We try to get an even number of 4-somes lined up each week and hope we don't get any last

minute cancellations. If someone finds out at the last minute they would like to play that week, we will do our best to accommodate them.

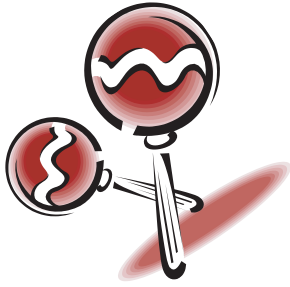
The line-ups for 4-somes are formulated in the computer, with about 25 different possibilities, for drawing up the 4-somes..Each 4-some adds up to the same handicap as every other 4-some, based on each individual's location on the A-B-C or D location on our line-up sheet each week. Now that everyone is thoroughly confused, please read on!

Based on our 2007 rates, each golfer will pay \$37.00 each week, with \$19.00 going to the Golf Club and the other \$18.00 going to the prize money, which is distributed each week at our Elks Club after each day's outing, based on each teams' score, birdies or holes-in-one made, plus skins. Usually, every team but the last place team participates in the prize money, unless they were lucky enough to get one or more skins.

We usually start at 9:30 AM in April and again after Labor Day, with 9:00 AM starting times during the summer months and hope we do not get any rain-outs, snow-outs, or whatever during the year. To equalize the 4-somes as much as possible, each player's drive must be used twice on the front nine and twice on the back nine and to further make it competitive, the "C" and "D" players are allowed to tee-off from the front T's..

Again, we invite all those who have not joined us in the past for this weekly day of fun, laughter, skill and plain old luck, to join our 'scrambles' group on Wednesdays to add to your summer's fun and frustration. Just leave your name and phone number with one of the bartenders and either Don Kirkham, Bill Berrington or Jim Syme will contact you and "sign" you up" - you won't regret it!
