#### Scholarship News

The Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce that Lodge 1523 had a \$1,000 finalist this year. <u>Regan Shannon</u> will receive a one-time payment of \$1,000 for being one of the 60 students to receive this honor. He is a senior at Royal Oak High School.

A total of 716 students from Michigan high schools applied for scholarship monies this year. This is down slightly from 2011. Seventeen students have advanced to the national level for judging in April.

We Elks should be very proud of the scholarship money that is spent every year on very promising students. Only the U.S. Government awards more money for college scholarships. There are 18 national awards given every year ranging from \$60,000 down to \$8,000.

We certainly wish all the finalists the very best of luck.
