She goes to a special camp in the summer for intense therapy for Cerebral Palsy patients. It costs her family several thousand dollars each year to send her there. She would like to go to a "fun" summer camp like other kids talk about, however the extra money for that isn't available to her parents. The Michigan Elks Major Projects supports kids like Elizabeth through a variety of methods, including the pink 365 banks you see on the bar in our lounge. Did you know what those banks were for or how much those few coins we drop in mean to a child? We think nothing of dropping \$40 or \$50 on a Saturday to play golf, but never think about making those banks a little heavier.

Will you consider taking a bank home to start filling it? They are referred to as 365 Banks because a penny a day for a year will fill it up. Of course nickels, dimes and quarters are accepted as well. The banks are available from your friendly bartender. I'm asking for your change for Elizabeth and other kids like her".



ELKS FOUNDATION NEWS

The 2010-11 fiscal year is officially closed. The final numbers are in, and we have some exciting news to share. First, we set another per-capita record. Per-member giving in 2010-11 reached an all-time high of \$6.618. That's nearly 30 cents more than the previous record, which we set in 2009-10. In addition, for the first time since 2007-08, actual donations, excluding bequests, increased.

Donations reached an all-time high of \$6.08 million in 2007-08, but they decreased in each of the next two years. We stopped that slide in 2010-11, raising our second highest total ever at \$5.91 million. Throw in bequests, and we took in \$8.53 million. That's our best year yet by more than \$1 million, and it's the second straight year that we topped the previous high by more than \$1 million.

So, 2010-11 was a fantastic year for the Foundation. Make sure that your Lodge shares in our success. A total of 1,574 Lodges achieved the GER's \$4.50 per-capita goal.

Each is eligible to receive a \$1,000 **Gratitude Grant**. Don't leave this money on the table. The application deadline is May 31. To learn more about Gratitude Grants and the Community Investments Program,
