ROYAL OAK LODGE AWARDED ELK'S NATIONAL FOUNDATION GRANT

Last summer our Lodge was awarded a \$2000 grant to assist our community in worthwhile projects from the Elks National Foundation. Your Board of Governors offered ideas and researched many to the projects that were going on in our community. They decided and approved the awarding of the following gifts to these projects: <code>Boys and Girls Club of Royal Oak</code> - \$1000 for the continue support of our Hoop Shoot Activities, <code>WW II Memorial</code> – Purchase of an engraved paver brick for the new memorial being planned in the 13 mile and Woodward area with a donation of \$500, <code>Wounded Warrior Program</code> – We researched and found a Royal Oak student who was a graduate of Royal Oak High School in 2001 and went on to graduate from the Air Force Academy. Timothy Hughes passed away in April of 2012 and asked that contributions be made to this program. A \$500 contribution was made in his memory.

Some of you maybe wondering why we did not keep this money for ourselves and our Lodge. National Foundation applies strict guidelines for its use and the donations we make have to be approved by them. We think that these contributions were worthy causes for our community. 


