A very moving event to have happened to me on Memorial Day.

We observed Flag Day on June 14th and our program was moving. We accepted the flag of fellow Elk, Tom Robertson which adorned the casket of his son Petty Officer 3rd class Chris Robertson. We took our old tattered flag down from the flag pole and proudly hoisted the newly donated flag in his memory. We will periodically fly this flag on special occasions. We thank Tom for his donation.

I tell you these stories as we celebrate this month the 4th of July, the birth of our nation, to remind you to always remember our veterans and as citizens to respect our flag and all that it stands.

Wishing you all a wonderful summer, I will be attending the national Elk's convention July 4 – 8 in Orlando, Florida.

Over the last several months, our clubroom is becoming an unpleasant place to be due to gossip, rumors and criticism of other members, officers and our staff. One of the corner stones of our organization is Brotherly Love which teaches us to forgive and forget and unfortunately, we have drifted well away from that. In an effort to make our clubroom a friendly, safe place to be, we are asking everyone to review our club rules below and make every effort to following them. No one wants to be the subject of ugly gossip, and should therefore, not create nor pass gossip about others. Thank you.

ROYAL OAK LODGE #1523 B.P.O.E. CLUB RULES

- Club privileges are extended to all Elks possessing a paid up membership card.
- Visiting members possessing a paid up membership card from another Lodge shall be permitted to use the facilities after signing the guest register.
- A member is allowed to entertain as many guests as they can be responsible for, providing all guests are properly registered plus guests must leave when sponsoring member leaves unless sponsored by another member.
- Members are requested and encouraged to use their Key Card to gain access to the club room. Members shall exhibit their membership card upon request of an officer or bartender.
- Last call for drinks shall be 15 minutes before closing of the bar. If there are ten or more members still in the club room drinking at closing time the bar will stay open. If there are less than ten it is at the bartender's discretion to close or stay open. However, in NO case shall drinks be served after 1:45a.m.
- The club room shall be open during posted operating hours.
- Spouses and eligible children of members possessing a membership card are permitted in the club room but are not permitted to sign in guests.
- All persons under the age of 18 must vacate the club rooms by 8:30p.m. and must be under the supervision of their parents at all times including while playing games. No one under the age of 21 may sit at the bar.
- Members and their guests will act in an adult and responsible manner while on the premises. No loud, aggressive or boisterous conduct will be allowed.
- No vulgarity will be allowed on premises.
- Anyone guilty of an act unbecoming a lady or gentleman will be reported to the Board of Governors for corrective action.
- No member or guest will be allowed to purchase alcohol if it is determined that they have had too much to drink. This will be enforced by the bartender with everyone's best interest in mind.
- The club shall be under the supervision and control of the Board of Governors.
- The bartender, Club manager or any Officer on the premises is expected to enforce these rules and to report any member who is in violation of the rules to the BOG.

All members and their guest shall refrain from malicious gossip about other members, officers and staff. Our Lodge should be an enjoyable place to come without fear of criticism.
